During the year, Vendetta Mining Corp exercised their Call Option to acquire 100% interest in the Pegmont lead-zinc Project Tenements, namely Mining Leases 2620, 2621 and 2623, also EPM 26210 plus camp facilities for an exercise payment of \$3million plus Option extension fees. This brought an end to the Company's direct involvement in the Pegmont project after almost 25 years. However, the Company retains a 1.5% NSR royalty, payable once Vendetta has recovered \$5million in production payments. The Directors have placed a nominal value on the royalty of \$100,000 at 31/12/2019.

Franking credits available and prospects for paying fully or partly franked dividends for at least the next year

Due to the payment of tax the company has franking credits amounting to \$3,711,014 available for payment of a dividend. Dividends will be paid when the board of Directors decide. As indicated by the Directors last year since Vendetta exercised its option during the year a dividend of 2.25 cents per share was paid to shareholders.


